
Re: Alberta Lake Management Society

I have resided in the hamlet of South Cooking Lake for three years, and during that time have noted a decline in lake level, and the beginning of changes in water vegetation.

It was interesting to aid the water monitoring program of your Society on Cooking Lake this last summer and to review the preliminary results. Cooking Lake, already eutrophic, appears to have almost a doubling in salt concentrations.

The continuation of the ALMS monitoring program on Cooking Lake is critical, for the hamlet, and for me personally as a resident.

I hope it will be possible to work together again this summer, to continue this important research on Cooking Lake.
